

Roaming Solutions

Bilateral roaming agreements take many years to implement and are high in both cost and resource. Typically a roaming service can take over 6 months to launch from agreement to testing to go live, moreover there is all of the commercial negotiations to get preferred partner status

International Network Extensions (INE) (Inbound Solution)

Our inbound solution is through an INE (International Network Extension), we use the clients access network and then through our QuickRoam platform, all of the traffic, control and governance comes back to JT. This enables our existing inbound roaming agreements to be extended to another country. We do of course gain permission from our roaming partners as part of the process.

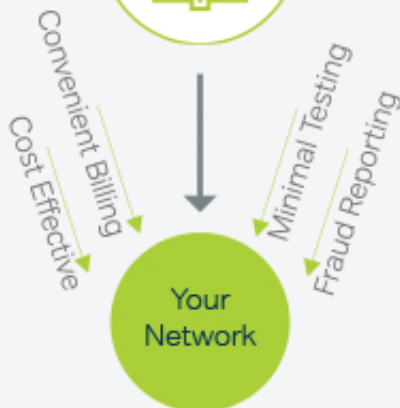
